PERALTA GOVERNING WORKSHOP MINUTES TUESDAY, APRIL 23, 2024

THE GOVERNING BODY FOR THE TOWN OF PERALTA HELD A WORKSHOP MEETING ON TUESDAY, APRIL 23, 2024 AT 6:00PM IN THE PERALTA TOWN HALL, 90-A MOLINA ROAD, PERALTA, NM 87042.

1. CALL TO ORDER - Meeting was called to order at 6:05pm by Mayor Olguin. All Governing Body members are present; Councilors Claudio Moya, Randy Smith, Joseph Romero and Mayor Pro Tem Leon Otero.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE - was led by Mayor Olguin.

3. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE WORKSHOP AGENDA for April 23, 2024. Motion to approve the April 23 agenda was made by Councilor Romero, second by Councilor Otero. The agenda was approved.

4. DISCUSSION TO INCREASE THE TOWN OF PERALTA MIL LEVY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY – WORK SHOP; Suggestion had been made before the Governing Body to increase the Property Mil-Levy Tax with the increased funds to be used towards Public Safety expenses.


Mayor Olguin presented a past reason to implement the purpose necessary to establish a Mil Levy. At that time the need was for a waster water system to preserve the ground water that current Peralta residents rely on for household use. Mayor Olguin then asked the Town Treasurer to present the future need to establish town expenses concerning Public Safety.

Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Robbins presented the current expenses and the future projected Public Safety expenses. He emphasized that Public Safety includes: Fire Protection, Emergency Medical Services, Law Enforcement Protection, Animal Control and Code Enforcement. DC/Treasurer Robbins emphasized that it is his duty to ensure the Town of Peralta Annual Budget has and maintains sufficient revenue to meet all current and future expenses. He encouraged the Governing Body to prepare for future expenses to included: Public Safety, Public works, Municipal streets and Waste water. It is his recommendation, as agreed by the Town Clerk that the Peralta Governing Body consider an increase of 2 Mils, from .003 to .005 for residential and commercial properties. All reports are attached. Councilor Smith recommended that the Governing Body be presented with an Action Item at the next Town Council meeting for Discussion and Possible Approval of such Action to Increase the Town of Peralta Mil Levy by .200 (from .300 to .500). Second was by Councilor Moya.

5. NEXT MEETING – THE NEXT REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING WILL BE HELD on Tuesday, May 14, 2014 at 6:00PM at the Peralta Town Hall, 90-A, Molina Road, Peralta, NM 87042.

6. ADJOURNMENT - Mayor Olguin asked for a motion to adjourn the workshop, Motion to adjourn was made by Councilor Smith, second by Councilor Moya. Meeting was adjourned at 6:41pm.
